DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut the page along the dotted line, and then cut out each Moon Phase Square along the solid black line.
- 2. <u>WRITE</u> the correct name of the Moon Phase on the line inside each Moon Phase Square piece, and then <u>WRITE</u> the order of the Moon Phases inside each Moon Phase Square piece, starting <u>CLOSEST</u> to the Sun and starting with #1, and ending at #8.
- 3. **DRAW** arrows on both the left and right sides of the orbit in the **COUNTERCLOCKWISE** direction, showing the direction that the Moon is revolving around the Earth. This is the direction in which you will paste each Moon Phase Square piece.
- 4. <u>PASTE</u> each Moon Phase Square, in the correct order, into the correct box on the Moon's Orbit around the Earth, found in the center of the diagram. <u>(KEEP IN MIND WHERE THE SUN IS POSITIONED)</u>
